

Wahnapiatae First Nation - General Election 2012

Polling Notice

Notice is hereby given to eligible voters of the Wahnapiatae First Nation Indian Band that a general election poll will be held Saturday, June 16th, 2012, to elect one (1) Chief and four (4) Councillors of the Band, and that such poll will be open from eight (8:00) o'clock a.m. local time until eight (8:00) o'clock p.m. local time in the Wahnapiatae First Nation Fire Hall. I will count the votes that same day, Saturday June 16th, 2012, at the same location immediately after the close of the poll and declare the results of the election.

All members of Wahnapiatae First Nation whether they are living on-reserve or off-reserve, who are eighteen (18) years of age or older on Saturday, June 16th, 2012, are eligible voters and may cast a ballot in person or by mail-in.

Registration forms are available for resident members that cannot attend the polling station on the day of the election or for non-resident members wishing to vote by mail-in ballot. Registration forms may be obtained by contacting the Electoral Officer's office at (705) 741-3773 or by e-mail at scott.jacobs@sympatico.ca. Registration forms will be only be accepted until 6:00 pm on May 18th, 2012, after which ballots will be sent out on May 25th, 2012, to registered voters only. Registered voters are not eligible to vote at the polling station. All non-registered voters wishing to cast a ballot, must vote in person at the polling station on Saturday, June 16th, 2012.
